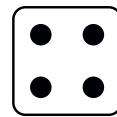
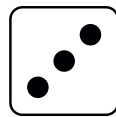
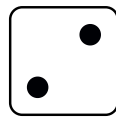
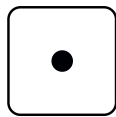
Each stocking is hung with care by the fireplace the night before. Santa fills stockings with gifts. The kids love to find their gifts on Christmas morning!

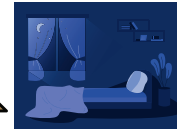

Big Firework Displays
